### After School Programs

This fall we launched our After School Programs for the kids in the neighborhood. It has long been our desire to help tutor and educate the underserved children in the inner city. We have found that many of our children are unable to read or even recite their alphabet. As

result, we have started the Learning Center. We provide after school tutoring three days a week, as well as creative arts, reading programs and fun learning activities. In addition, we provide a healthy after

school snack for all the kids. We currently have 15-20 neighborhood children who attend daily. Many receive help with reading, math and spelling. Thanks to Rachel and Sarah for their labor of love.

### Bible Camp

Following up on our successful summer Bible Camp, we continue to provide a Biblical after school program for the children. At Bible Camp we teach Bible lessons, scriptures, have praise and worship and teach our kids to walk in the righteousness and power of God. It is such a joy to see them grow in God!

### Bible Study

In October we began our Bible Study (Small Group) for adults. Wednesday nights we meet for the food, fellowship and the Word with the neighborhood. We are seeing people's lives changed by the power of God. This month we will add a Monday morning Bible study as well.

### Mission Teams

Last year we had over 200 lay ministers join us in ministry. They came from as close as New Orleans and as far away as Canada. What an awesome time we had!

In November and December, they helped to serve the community and joined us in two of our biggest outreaches of the year, Cajun Thanksgiving and Christmas Outreach. In addition some helped in the rebuilding of the All Nations Fellowship facility, which was damaged by Katrina flood waters.

## Salvation Testimony

*They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the LORD for the display of his splendor. Is 61:3*

It was at one of our neighborhood outreaches this past summer that we met a young man named "Ronnie." That day he seemed extremely anxious as he held his newborn daughter in his arms.

Our ministry team approached him and learned that "Ronnie," in his early twenties, had already been through a lot in life. He had grown up in poverty, lived in a rough neighborhood where hustling was the only way to survive. He had also spent time in jail as a result of some bad decisions.

He admitted that he had been sought out by a friend to take part in breaking into homes to make some "fast money". He shared that

he was struggling to do the "right" thing.

Our team member began to share that God loved him and had a plan for his life. "Ronnie" seemed to be listening, but uncertainty flooded his heart. Still, he allowed our team to pray for him before he walked off to meet his friend.

As we left the outreach that day we continued to pray that the seeds of truth about God's love for "Ronnie" would bear fruit.

The following Sunday he came to church and gave his life to the Lord. He later shared that He turned down the opportunity to make "fast money" and it had cost him not only his friends, but his child. The mother had moved her away because of his decision to do "right".

Despite his loss, he knew he had made the "right" decision. His heart was hurting, but the Father was now beginning to fill it with his love and revelation.

Today, "Ronnie" continues to grow in God, as he surrounds himself with his new family. He is eager to learn the things of God, faithfully attends our weekly Bible Study and a few weeks ago God blessed him with a job.

We are so excited to be a part of God touching and changing lives and displaying His glory in the community! Please continue to pray for "Ronnie" and for more fruit in this city.
