Our annual Back 2 School Bash is one of the ways we help needy families in the area. With the help of donors, over 150 children

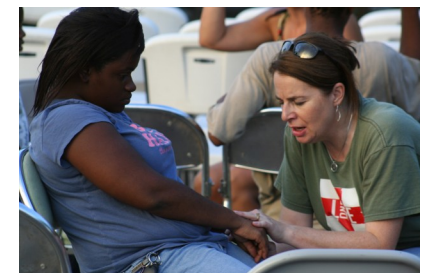
received free school supplies, along with hamburgers, hot dogs, face painting and sno-balls! We were also able to help several children with school uniforms.



Urban Vibe

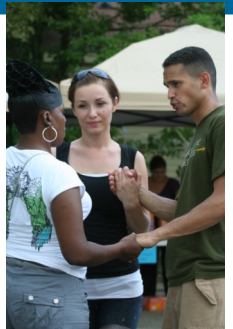
In August, we partnered with All Nations Fellowship for the *Urban Vibe Outreach*. We provided free food, music, games and freeze-pops to the community. In addition,

“My friends you were chosen to be free. So don’t use your freedom as an excuse to do anything you want. Use it as an opportunity to serve each other with love.” (Gal 5:13 CEV)
